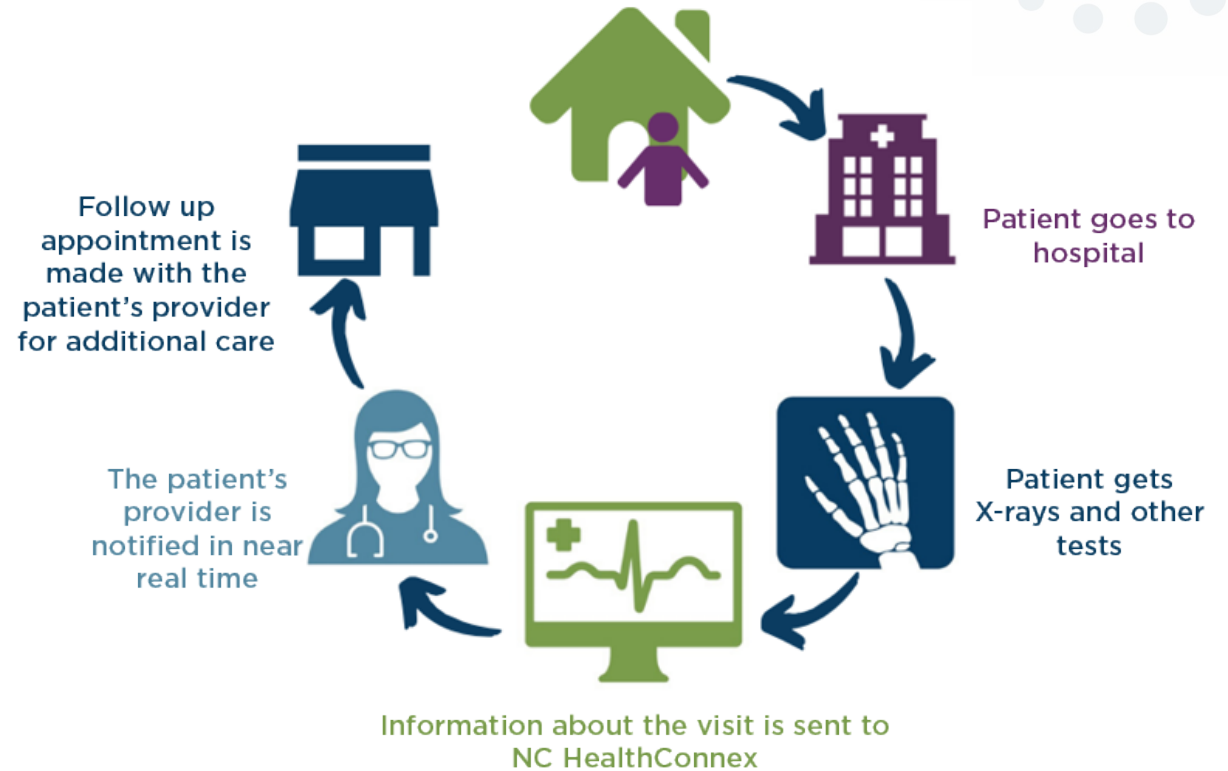


NC*Notify – How it Works

Our goal is to keep your providers and care teams in the know when your patients have a care event at another facility..

The green house represents your organization with the patient assigned to your facility in purple. When they receive care, an ADT message, such as an X-ray taken at another facility, is created and sent to NC HealthConnex.

After receiving the alert, our system will match the patient with your facility and immediately send an event notification to your NC*Notify Dashboard. In your case, your Dashboard will only be populated with Maternal Health Alerts.

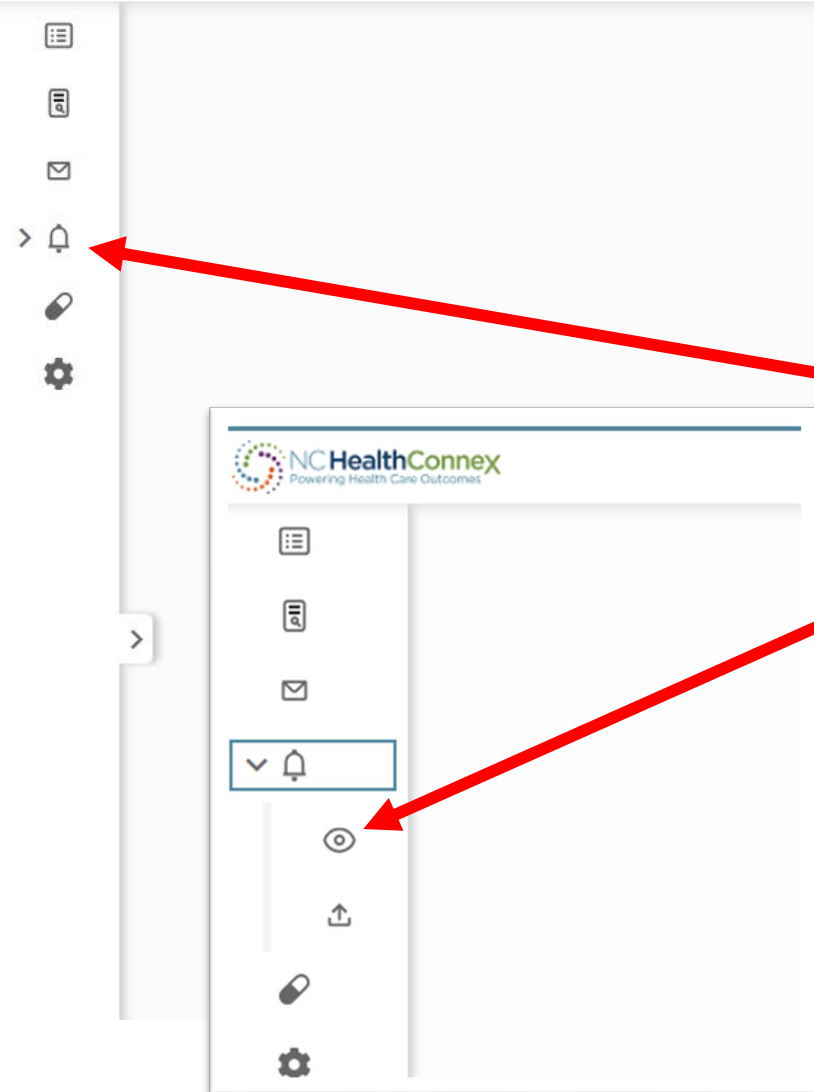

1. Care Coordination or Progress Tabs – These tabs will help members of your team better understand (at a glance) which patients have been interacted with.

As new Maternal alerts appear on the dashboard they will land within the “All or Not Started” tabs by default. This is because they have not yet been engaged by a care team member.

2. Status Bubbles – These bubbles work directly with the tabs in section one.

Example: If patient A lands in the local ED with elevated blood pressure, that alert will land on the dashboard. A nurse sees the alert and starts the follow up procedure by clicking the middle half gray bubble (In Progress).

When the follow up work has been completed, the care team member would select the green “Completed” bubble.

As the bubbles are selected, the event notification for patient A is sent to the appropriate tab.

All team members within that clinic will have the ability to see which patients are in progress and which have been completed, which helps to avoid multiple team members reaching out to the same patient.

4. Filtering Field – This field allows users to build filters by keywords within the notifications. This helps users find the notifications that are most meaningful to them. These filters can be very specific to include categories such as event type, time, date, primary care provider and many others.
